John 8:1-11

1 But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.
2 Now early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people came to Him; and He sat down and taught them.
3 Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst,
4 they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act.
5 Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?"
6 This they said, testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear.
7 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first."
8 And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground.
9 Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.
10 When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?"
11 She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more."

Can We Separate the Sin from the Sinner?

One of the hardest things to do is to not see people as their sin. When it's a "little" sin, as we like to call them, it's easy to overlook because we too struggle with such things. However, when it's what we consider to be a "major" sin, the person who's committed it becomes villainized in some of our minds. It's true that in the Law of Moses, punishments varied according to which law was broken. Some entailed harsher penalties than others, and not a few resulted in death. However, have you ever noticed that those meant to result in death seldom did?

Can you find an example in the New Testament where the Law was followed literally? Based on the woman caught in adultery, she should have been put to death along with her fella. Instead, Jesus reminded the crowd that he who was without sin could throw the first stone. This wasn't a condoning of her sin, but it was a rebuke of those who thought themselves self-righteous. Jesus didn't say, "Whoever's not committed a major sin can throw the first stone," but whoever hadn't sinned. Our Savior reminds us that when we're prone to heave stones at a sinner that we too must remember that we aren't necessarily angels.

What I find helpful is when someone sins, I try to put myself in their shoes. Now, that doesn't mean that I commit the sin or that it's even something with which I struggle. I try to think how I'd want people to view and treat me. When folks look at me as a walking, living disease, because that will hurt. I'd rather someone lovingly come to me and try to reason with me. There are some people special in our lives that we love very much, and they sin. At least if we talk to them about how much we love, how God loves them, and how God wants them to not sin that sin, we can say that we've tried. They're a person trapped in sin and someone that God loves very much.

The Question of God *Ernie Bailey*

For 25 years, Dr. Armand Nicholi, Jr. studied the basic philosophical writings of Sigmund Freud & C. S. Lewis and his 2002 book titled *The Question of God* is his synthesis of the ideas of both of these very different men on various topics but, as the title suggests, the primary topic was God.

Freud (1856-1939) and Lewis (1889-1963) both became world famous but for different reasons. Both struggled at one point with belief in God but it was Lewis whose journey led him to famously transition from atheism to Christianity and to write some of the best apologetic books in the English language. Freud's story, on the other hand, was much sadder. The book # in our library is 211/Nic/2002.
