Funeral Meal Program

Step by step we are resuming programs that were put on hold due to the Covid crisis.

One of the programs that I am happy to mention today, is supplying funeral meals here at the building. For the last several months we have restricted the supply and serving of food to homes of individuals rather than having the use of the building as an option.

We are now opening the building as being an available option for a meal in addition to their home.

A member of the Glendale Road Church or the Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Son, Daughter, Grand-son, Grand-daughter, or Spouse of a member are offered a meal to be of help in this difficult time.

If you're on Instagram, this handle is an account begun by a fellow named Ben Kirby. He started it because he started asking questions about the lifestyle of rich and famous celebrity preachers. It began sort of as a joke, but as time went on, he noted one Seattle megachurch "pastor" who wore a \$3,600 jacket, another who had on a \$1,250 fanny pack, and another wore a \$2,541 crocodile belt.

These sorts of things make me cringe. I don't envy these people their money or even the fashionable items they wear. I once had a man visit me here at Glendale who sold suits. He brought his fabric samples and other things to show me the quality of the suits he sold. As we went through book after book of fabric samples, I came to one that I particularly liked and asked for a ballpark price. After picking my jaw up off the floor, I told him how lovely his samples were but that I couldn't in good conscience spend the kind of money he was asking for a suit. It wasn't because I didn't think it worth it. Still, because of being somewhat modest, there are certain things that I am just unwilling to spend a certain amount on them no matter how nice they are. For example, Rolex watches can cost over \$50,000. I can get a \$30 watch that tells the same time. I just can't envision spending that kind of money on a watch.

When Scripture addresses how Christians should dress, the Bible never had to urge that we "cover-up" because so many showed skin. Instead, the Bible addressed the matter as not being ostentatious. That is, don't be too flashy. Be simple. Be modest. Let "women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with propriety and moderation, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing, but, which is proper for women professing godliness, with good works" (1 Tim. 2:9-10). "Do not let your adornment be merely outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel—rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God" (1 Peter 3:3-5).
