#### **Citing Creation Order**

When Paul justified his prohibition of women teaching and having authority over men, he referred to the beginning when God made Adam and Eve (1 Tim. 2:11–14). Various scholars have attempted to explain this passage away. Some have said that in Ephesus, which was where Timothy was, was the temple of Artemis. In that cult, women were the priests, so some who had converted to Christianity were used to being in control, and Paul had to reign them in. Others have suggested that since women weren't afforded proper education, their ignorance resulted in their silence in the church. Finally, some have proposed that Paul's prohibition was a cultural thing that need not apply today.


However, when Paul cites creation order, he does not mention it because of cultural, education, or leadership concerns. Instead, creation order was his guide to an apparent problem in the Ephesian church while Timothy was there. Anytime creation is cited, it is timeless and a principle that transcends culture and education. Therefore, the command that women were not to teach or have authority over men is still applicable to the present day.

Another example of citing the creation order appeared when Jesus was asked about divorce in Matthew 19:1–12. While many claims that Jesus never spoke against this or that, He did talk positively about marriage and what it should be by invoking the creation order. One man, one woman. That's it. This was God's design for the home. Divorce was permitted because of a hard heart, but that was not the case from the beginning. Jesus went on to explain the consequences of violating this order in verse nine.

Paul also cited creation to the Corinthians. I confess that this passage is somewhat enigmatic to me. I'm sure others have a better handle on it, but in 1 Corinthians 11:8–9, in the discussion about head coverings, he, once more, cites creation. Women have a covering on their heads, but their hair is given as a covering (verse 15). Again, this may be a specific topic that deserves greater study, but, for now, I wanted to point out that the invocation of creation makes a matter timeless.

#### YE Thankful People E. Bailey

Another in the top rung of Thanksgiving hymns that will be sung in countless churches later this month is Henry Alford's "Come, Ye Thankful People, Come" which is # 729 in our current hymnal, written in 1844. Henry Alford (1810-1871) led a varied career as churchman, theologian, textual critic, scholar, poet and hymn writer.

One aspect that has led to the universal popularity of this hymn is the tune to which it was paired. ST GEORGE'S WINDSOR was composed in 1858 by George Elvey (1816-1893). Elvey's tune is written in a good straight 4/4 time which renders it "singable" by congregations and was composed at a time well before the modern "worship songs" of our era.

This hymn has found its place in the classic hymn repertoire of Christianity.
