The Premise of the Pattern

The book of Hebrews was written to encourage Jewish Christians on the brink of apostasy because of persecution to stay the course. The preacher of the book did this to explain in detail how Jesus was far more supreme to Judaism and its rites and rituals. As Christians often have throughout the centuries, those saints wondered whether following Jesus was worth the cost of personal well-being, comfort, happiness, and security. What they endured, the preacher contended, was akin to the sufferings of the Lord and that the heavenly city that awaits the faithful disciple of Christ is that place to which we all desire to go. One specific argument was to show how the Temple cult and its worship were inferior because it was a copy and shadow of heaven.

What occurred at the Temple was unlike the Christian worship (Hebrews 8:5). This Temple was born out of Israel's Tabernacle in the wilderness, a portable Mount Sinai (Hebrews 12:18-21)—the first place Israel worshiped God as a congregation. When we follow the progression, we note how similar Mount Sinai is to heaven. The only difference is that the former is on earth and invoked fear and trembling. The latter, however, is a joyful assembly, and Christian worship in the body (church) is not the earthly mountain of fear and trembling. Christian worship is heavenly, which is why we do not fear as they did and have so many regulations and rites to perform. The blood of Jesus, better than that of lambs and goats, has so thoroughly cleansed us that we go into the assembly unafraid (Hebrews 12:22-24).

So if heaven is the pattern, there should be a unity between Israel's worship and Christian worship, in a sense. Revelation 4-5 reveals to us heavenly worship, and it is this pattern upon which we worship our God. John received the Revelation on the Lord's Day when he was in the spirit—another way of saying that he was in worship. In these two chapters, you will note that songs and prayer are offered both to God and Jesus that joins a procession of such provided by the angels and hosts of heaven. This is done in heaven night and day, unceasingly. The scroll opened, read, and explained is akin to our reading of Scripture and sermon in the assembly. Two things we don't see in heavenly worship are the Lord's Supper and the offering. These two things were specific to worship on earth. The meal was our portion in the atoning work of God. Once we're before Him, there is no longer a need for this because it anticipates the Lord's return while simultaneously proclaiming His death (1 Corinthians 11:26). No offering is needed in heaven because God sustains everything. At the same time, on earth, we contribute from what God has gifted us to maintaining His Temple, the church (1 Corinthians 3:16-17).
